NATIONAL LEVEL OF COLLABORATION

- **University/Institute** (with whom partnership memoranda have been signed - enterprises, state authorities (state administration, local government, territorial communities), industry associations and other stakeholders of the ecosystem).
- **Department/laboratory**
- **Industry associations**
- **Independent search** (take care of your business card, website, page in social networks), etc.
- **Participation in expert groups** (competitions MESU, NAQA, NRF)
- **Participation in the councils of young scientists, cooperation with the RMU under the Ministry of Education and Science**

Levels of international scientific cooperation

- **Start with yourself** (English language (certification test for knowledge of the English language, publications, individual cooperation, joining the team))
- **Research supervisor** (your contacts can become PhD candidate's contacts)
- **Department and laboratory**

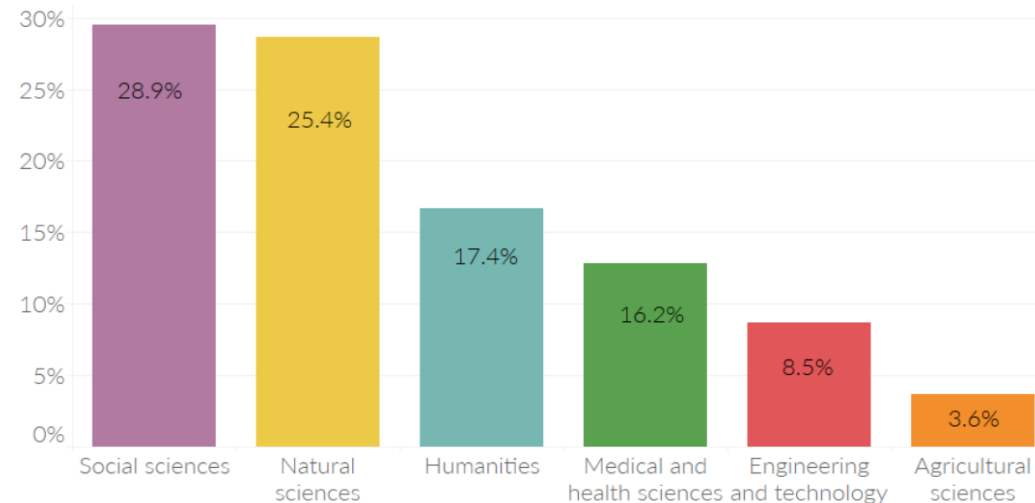
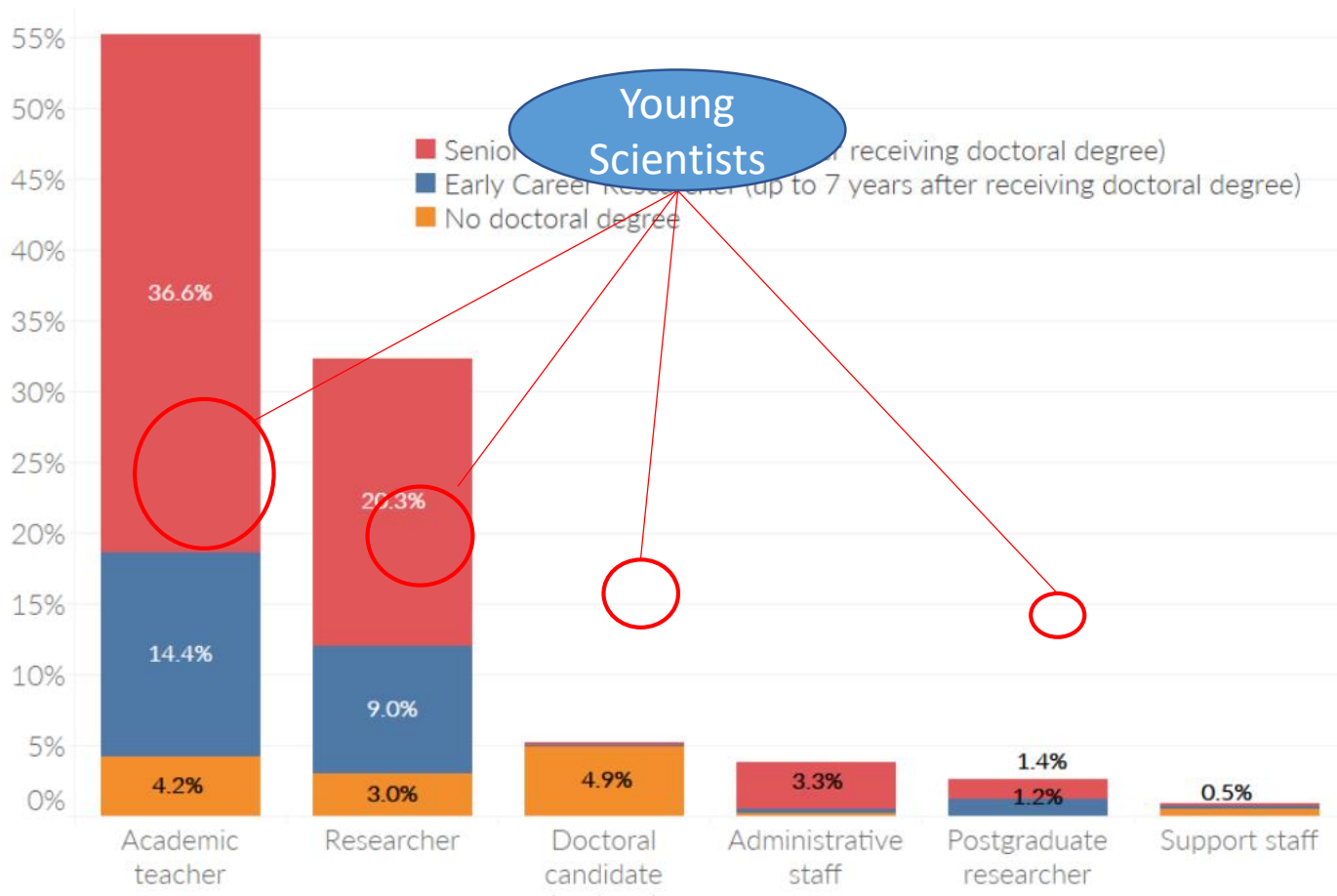
Ukrainian scientists abroad including young scientists



- A young scientist is a scientist under the age of 35, inclusive, who has a higher education at least second (master's) level, or a scientist under the age of 40, inclusive, who has a scientific degree of Doctor of Sciences.



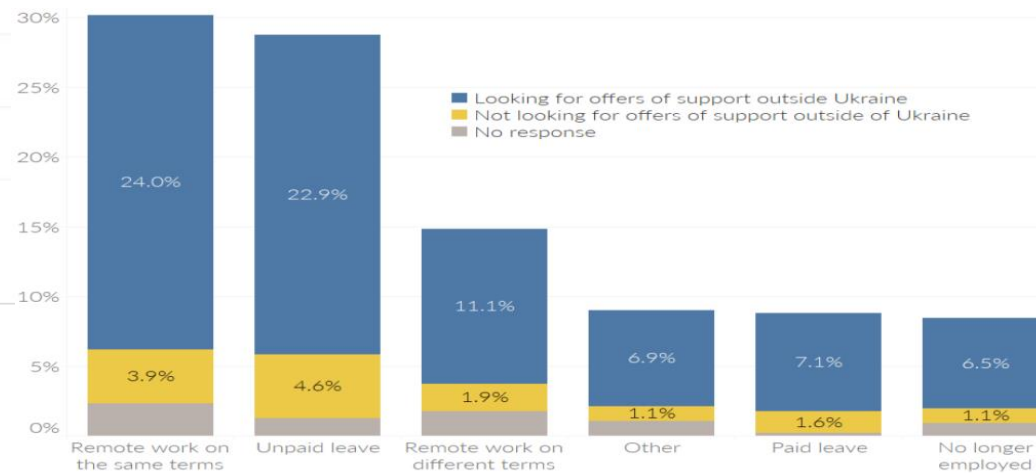

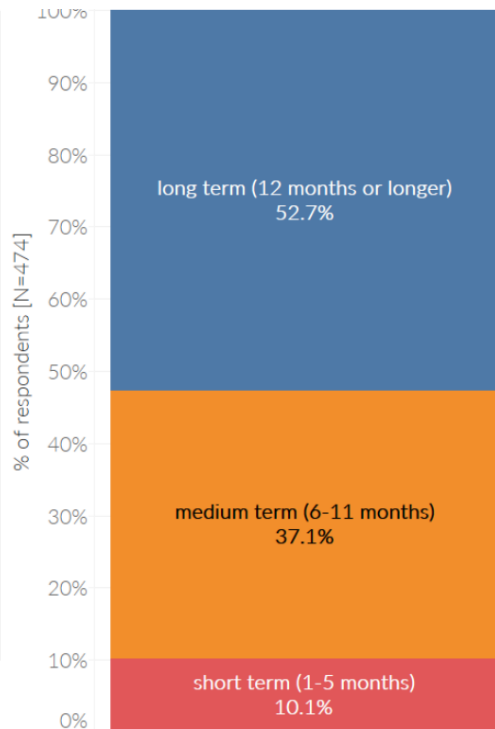
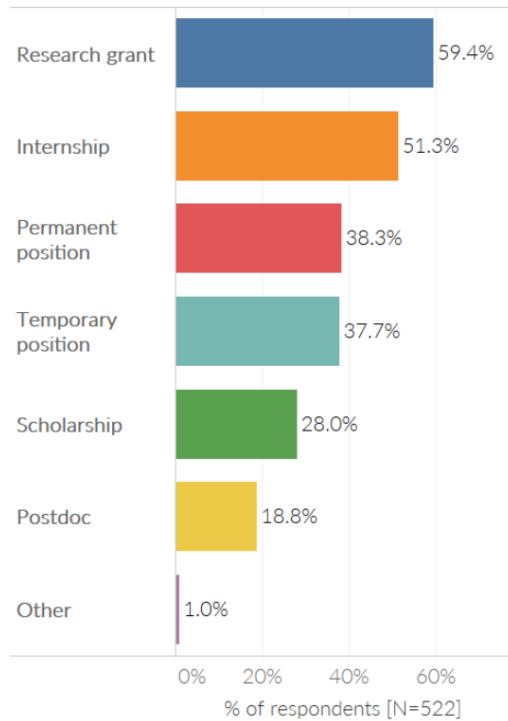
OECD research areas



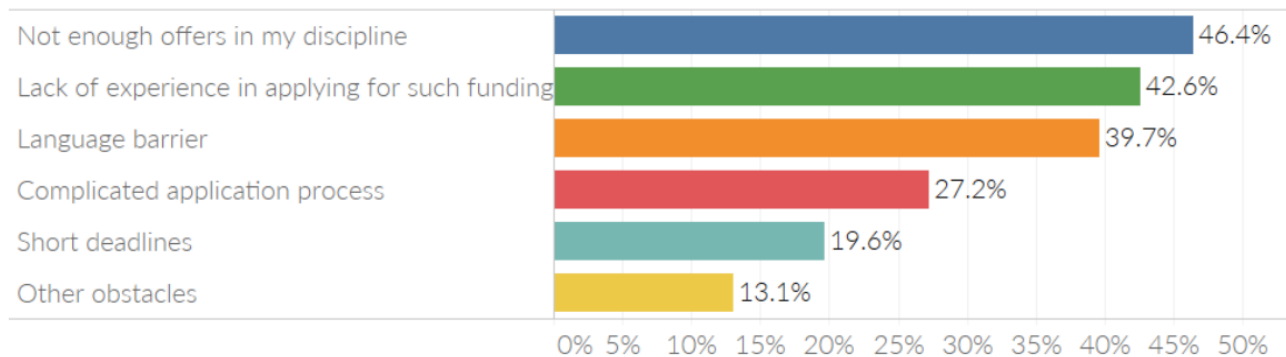
The professional situation abroad



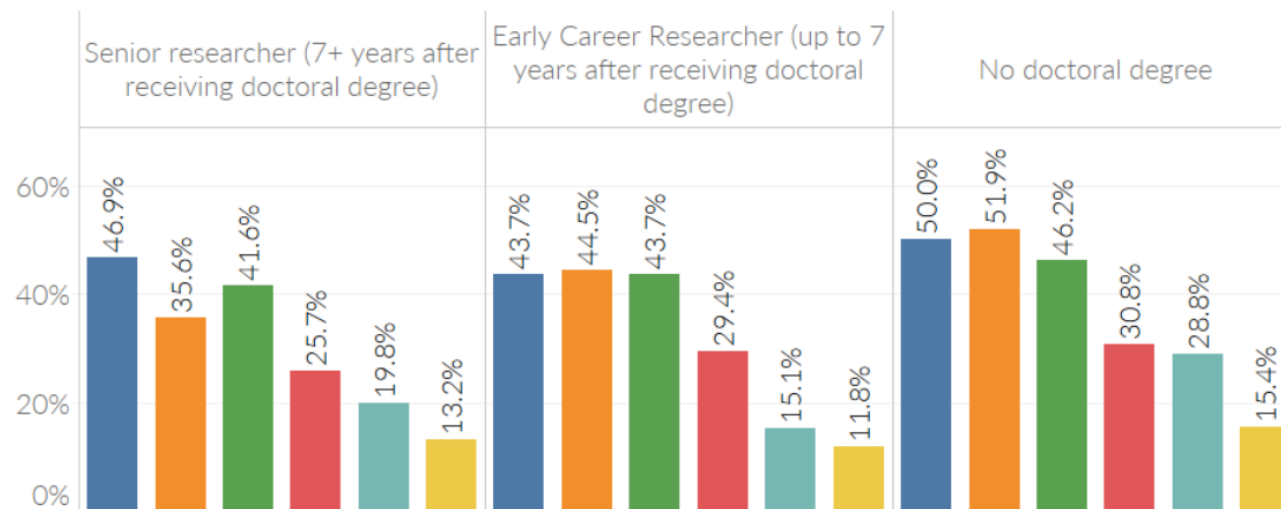
Relationship with the home institution

Why Ukrainian Science Diaspora?

- more than 5 000 scholars abroad who left Ukraine after invasion (according to the MESU's assessment)
- requests from colleagues abroad to invite Ukrainian scholars in HE consortium
- huge demand for human capital at the recovery phase

- The Scholar Support Office at the the Young Scientists Council at the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine has launched the **“Українська наукова діаспора | Ukrainian Science Diaspora” initiative.**
- The **aim** of the initiative is to unite the efforts of Ukrainian scientists abroad for further joint research projects, develop tools for their support programs, and their return to Ukraine.

Who is invited to be a part of Ukrainian Science Diaspora?

Those **individuals**

- 1) who do not live in Ukraine
- 2) who have Ukrainian citizenship or relate themselves originally as Ukrainians (have Ukrainian roots)
- 3) who have or had a status of scientist/researcher
- 4) who are interested in common research and other projects related to the recovery and development of Ukraine

The Ukrainian Science Diaspora's actions:

- Identifying the needs of Ukrainian scientists for further development of a policy for their support.
- Engaging the Ukrainian scientific diaspora in dialogue and communication among themselves and with scientists who have remained in Ukraine.
- Consultations on establishing centers of Ukrainian scientific communities in different countries and support for their activities.
- Creating a mapping of the Ukrainian scientific diaspora and a database of those scientists who could participate in joint initiatives in the future.

Ukrainian Science Diaspora initiative will contribute to:

- strengthening of the cohesion of Ukrainians abroad for the implementation of ideas related to post-war reconstruction through science;
- improving of the image of Ukrainian science in the world;
- establishing of effective networking in various fields of science both within the Ukrainian scientific diaspora and between its representatives and scientists in Ukraine;
- Institutional cooperation between Ukrainian and foreign universities and research institutions;
- initiation of mentoring by those representatives of the Ukrainian scientific diaspora who have been living abroad for a long time;
- increasing of the representation of the scientific activity of community members;
- initiation and implementation of charity projects.

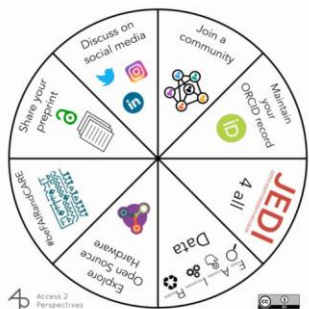
